Paslode Upgrades its Framing Nailer

Paslode was among the first toolmakers to offer a cordless framing nailer. It's not an easy task to pack enough punch into a cordless tool to sink framing nails, and do so with a fast recycle time.

But Paslode's upgraded version of its cordless framer meets the challenge.

Its new CF-325 Cordless Framing nailer is enhanced with an updated nosepiece that's far more aggressive than its predecessor and allows for toe-nailing at any angle.

It also fires much faster, with no delay between drives.

The new QuickLode Fuel System is much easier to install. It drives nails between 2 inches and 3 ¼ inches in length.
